Friends of Lighthouse Missions:

I rejoice in pains of disappointment and with tears of joy. Claver Temalilwa and I met last Saturday and shared coffee and bagels; and we shared our hearts – Claver is returning to Tanzania Tuesday, November 4th.

Claver's Son was killed one year ago by bandits, who were trying to rob their ministry of the funds to start their farm. Don's Son died in the Iraq war, and some of his death benefit was invested into African Restoration. Janie has suffered illness and injury in body and soul in this last year greater than she has ever known. These are just examples of the happenings that affects everyone who supports this Kingdom work.

Claver and I knew we were in agreement concerning the elements of African Restoration: (1) a 1,600 year proven history of a Chinese herb to cure Malaria, (2) the establishment of farms to produce a sustainable supply of this herbs utilizing community irrigation & management, and (3) a Christian ministry alliance which will deliver this cure as a herbal tea free to the poor in conjunction with the Gospel. We came into agreement upon the simple Kingdom message that is to be delivered along with the herbal cure. And, we now agree that the last year was a most difficult one to endure.

If Satan thought we would quit, he under estimated the power that binds us together. Foremost, the struggles that were meant to destroy have made us better equipped. Claver and I both say that we are now far better prepared for the tasks ahead, than we would have been last year. Praise God!

It seems strange that Claver's return to Tanzania on November 4th is probably of greater significance (that is to say will ultimately impact far more people to come into the Kingdom) than will the election of the President of the United States on that same day. I greatly appreciate your prayers in this matter. In addition, I would ask for prayer for the Kingdom work that lies ahead and the protection, provision and purpose of my beloved Janie, Stephen Brummitt, Ron Hatmaker, Tony Slay, Joseph Keretho and Josiah Muesha for their lives are to impact all of Africa.
